SCOPE

The Plumbing, Sanitary and Heating Equipment, Supplies and Associated Services Framework Agreement is split into three Lots;
Lot 1 – Plumbing and Sanitary Equipment, Supplies and Associated Services
Lot 2 – Heating Equipment, Supplies and Associated Services
Lot 3 – One Stop Shop

AGREEMENT BENEFITS

- Savings are generated by harnessing the buying power of all the participating consortia Members. The Framework Agreement provides an average saving of 12.47% over the three Lots;
- A multi Supplier Framework Agreement will ensure that Suppliers remain competitive through the life of the Framework Agreement; and
- Members have a quicker OJEU complaint access to the market and the Framework Agreement removes the need to conduct an OJEU tender. Members can Call-Off from the Framework Agreement through Direct Award or Further Competition saving considerable resources and thus providing savings to Members in terms of tendering costs of £6,000.

USING THE FRAMEWORK

The terms and conditions of the Framework Agreement have been defined and agreed at tender stage and must not be amended. Call-Off Contract terms and conditions such as payment terms can only be revised in agreement with the member and the Supplier.
